## Music Department Expectations for Professional Faculty

Professional faculty in the music department are those faculty whose teaching/administrative load is 24 hours per year. The following are guidelines for review and promotion:

## **Teaching**

Professional faculty in the music department are expected to teach in a variety of settings as needed in the department. This can include any of the following:

- classroom
- studio
- ensemble
- advising
- administrative support

## **Scholarship**

As a result of the large teaching/administrative load set for professional faculty, any scholarship is considered optional.

## Service

As a result of the large teaching load set for professional faculty, service to the college and the department is considered optional with one exception. Recruitment is a service that is crucial to the success of the music program. All professional faculty are expected to participate in the ongoing recruitment efforts of the music department.
